Visit of Shri Kamal Kumar Ji Barjatya

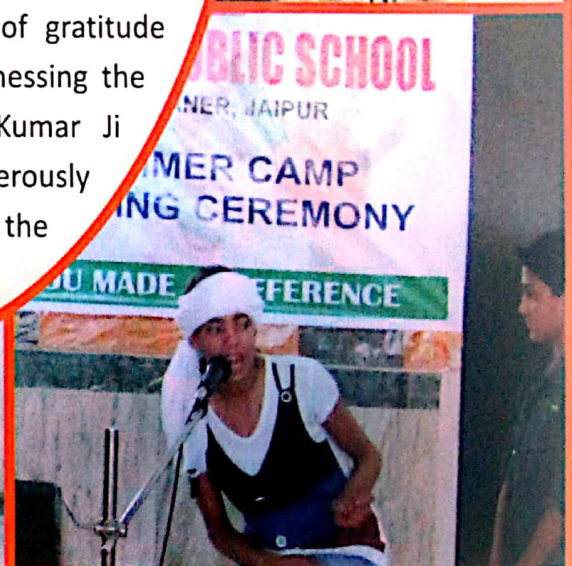
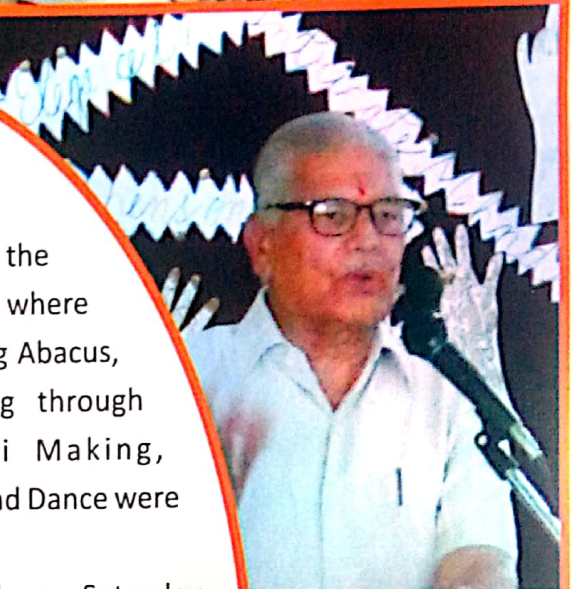
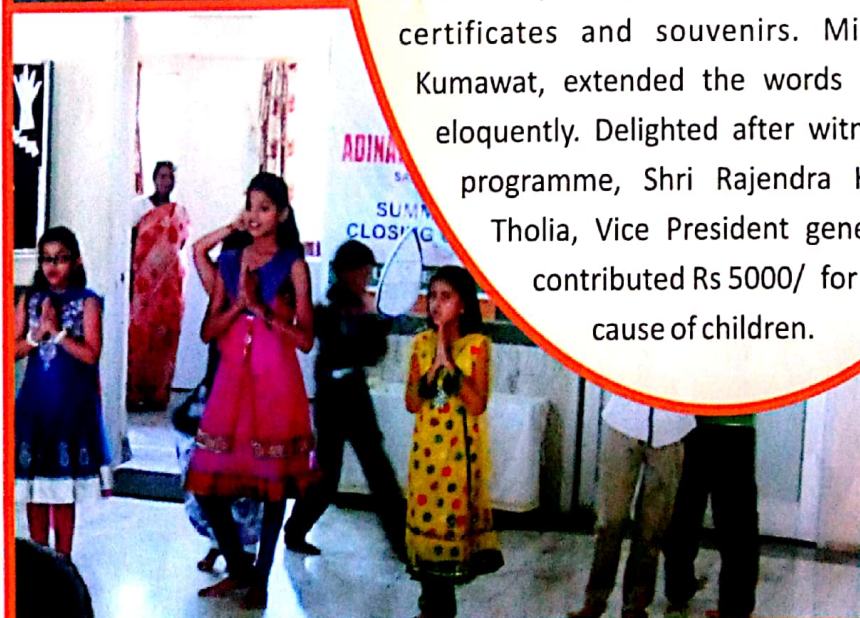
